New Medical Centre - Aldbrough St. John, North Yorkshire

Working with local doctors brp architects were appointed to design a new build project providing a 3no. GP surgery and training facility in the Yorkshire Dales. The site commands a prominent position on the edge of Aldbrough St John, overlooking the local village cricket club and on a road historically known as 'Doctors Lane' – a feature befitting the project!

Responding to the local vernacular the built form utilises a traditional palette of materials including natural stone and slate. The format

and composition of the building is such that it is intended to create the appearance of converted rural agricultural buildings.

The steep sloping nature of the site presented design challenges in order to ensure that level access could be achieved as well as integrating both staff and patient movements without compromising the overall building use and design.
