New Medical Centre - Ansdell, Lytham St. Annes

A successful winning entry as part of a national design competition the scheme is largely single storey in nature, centred around a two-storey core. The spatial arrangement offers an efficient, flexible design accommodating the diverse needs of primary care plus the ever-changing modus operandi of medical services provision and delivery.

Adopting a contemporary design, based around a central courtyard waiting space with an atrium and short stub corridors, this multi-user facility comprises a doctor's surgery,

dental suite, supported by counselling, podiatry and PCT services together with an independent pharmacy.

Conceptually the design provides an easy to use and manageable building, clearly zoned in terms of use / activity. This enables it to operate as a cohesive unit or as individual components – with each element able to be segregated from the core activity and used independently, i.e. out of hours.
