## Exhibition Centre - EOE Showground, Peterborough

Adopting a traditional procurement route brp architects were commissioned by the East of England Agricultural Society to design the first phase of their new exhibition complex, as well as to administer the contract.

Central to the development are the 2no. multi-function halls; one a 1,100m<sup>2</sup> space, the other a 4,500m<sup>2</sup> venue. Strong collaboration with the Engineer enabled an entirely clear span structural solution, using a mast and cable suspension support system to pre-cambered steel beams, giving a minimum clear height of

9m. Externally clad in robust dense masonry construction at low level with an acoustically modified lightweight cladding / roof system over ensures the spaces offer maximum flexibility in their use.

Pods containing welfare facilities, plant rooms etc. service the fully air-conditioned halls, ensuring they provide high quality conferences and hospitality suites plus act as a suitable venue for concerts, exhibitions and events such as show jumping.
