The Wheatcroft Collection Museum

BRP Partnership have completed the initial design for a new motor museum for what is to be the largest private collection of motor vehicles in the world.

Dedicated galleries will house collections as diverse as formula one racing cars to agricultural vehicles, and public transport to militaria.

The project is intended to be a haven for all interested in transport with activities ranging from the museum to on and off road test

circuits to showroom space for individual car manufacturing companies and support industries and commerce.

The roof structures covering individual exhibition halls of up to 6000sqm are designed as part suspended, lightweight, cable stayed structures offering clear flexible areas below.

Galleries sweep around enclosing the central reception, admin core designed as a curtain walled block, supported on a solid masonry plinth flanked by masonry buttresses.
