New Primary Care Centre - Greet Road, Winchcombe

Built in the shadow of the Cotswold escarpment this new-build four GP Surgery demonstrates the success of contemporary design within an established rural setting.

The scheme incorporates many innovative uses of otherwise traditional materials to the locality – including natural Cotswold stone, horizontal cedar boarding plus a high performance through-coloured render system. In addition to this the building uses a standing seam welded stainless steel roof that weathers down quickly to resemble traditional leadwork.

Adopting a cruciform plan format the building has a central 2-storey spine, supplemented by two single storey wings to each side – enabling a clear hierarchy to the built form and helping to integrate into the sloping site.

All external facing materials provide cladding to a loadbearing steel and timber inner frame, which offers endless flexibility and adaptation possibilities for the future. As such brp architects are currently in the process of designing a 350sqm extension to the building.
